READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY

THE DAY OF PENTECOST—MAY 27, 2012

ACTS 2:1-21: Gathered together in Jerusalem on the Jewish festival of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit comes upon the followers of Christ and propels them into the streets, speaking the languages of the earth and astonishing the inhabitants of the city.

PSALM 104: 24-34

THE LETTER OF PAUL TO THE ROMANS 8:22-27: Paul speaks of the believers' patient hope in things unseen and the Holy Spirit's intercession to help believers in their weakness.

JOHN 15:26-27; 16:4b-15: In the hours nearing his betrayal and arrest, Jesus assures his disciples with the promise that God will send a counselor, the spirit of truth, to bear witness to Jesus and to guide them in speaking the truth about him to the world.
